CPC Report: (Nelly K)

- Working with Kelsy to deliver literature to the court house.
- Reached out to World Service for an updated literature order form.

Intergroup Report: (Nick W)

- Treasurer: \$3,773.09 total balance for intergroup, about \$2500 is the intergroup's and the remaining balance being the bookstore's; PI's quarterly disbursement is around \$590 and is distributed in April, July, October, and January.
- Bookstore: Intergroup reps are to take back and discuss with their home groups whether or not to change their policy on sales tax-currently the customer does not pay sales tax on literature at point of sale and intergroup pays it quarterly; prices of literature from GSO just increased beginning of April; bookstore will be at workshop on April 29th so the bookstore will be closed that day.

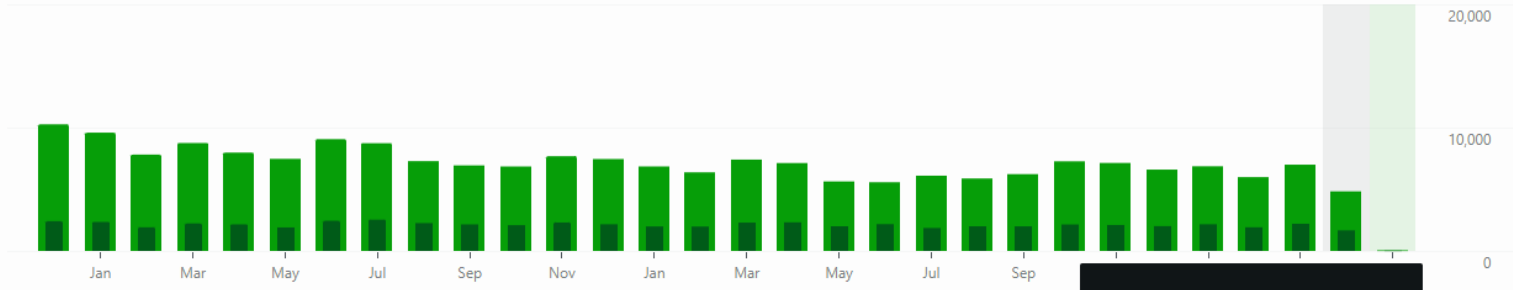

The website experienced a brief period of downtime on April 18th from about 9:45pm until 10:30 pm. This was a complete outage due to a malfunctioning wordpress plug in. I created full backups from the last known operational day of all data and version files from ipage immedietly, the plug in was deactivated, wordpress was updated to the newest version, and the site came right back up. I spoke to Marc the next day to get more information about what the plug in had been used for and he confirmed that it was not necessary for the stability or day to day operation of the site.

This outage did kick us off of jetpack for a few days so our stats are a bit skewed for views but there was no additional downtime after that.
