## Pork Area Intergroup **Treasurer's Report** For the month of June 2022

The month closed out with just normal expenses, which along with nominal contributions slightly increased YAI funds to approximately \$1,150 over Prudent Reserve. This excess will be eliminated with next month's scheduled outlays for 12<sup>th</sup> Step Work with P.I. and the Activities Committee, and of course, our obligation to pay Sales Tax on Book Store Sales to Pennsylvania.

Contributions are irregular, and as such, I offer no opinion on <u>how</u> the Representatives motion *should* use the funds available for 12<sup>th</sup> Step Work in the community; only that Representatives continue to do so. The groups seem respond to YAI's financial condition and how YAI uses their monies. Needs always seem to be filled, and funds only seem to dry up when the groups sense a lack of need, accountability, or if YAI would (ever) mistreat their funds.



The purpose of York Area Intergroup is to carry the message of AA to the community. This is essentially 12-Step work. To fund YAI's outreach, individual groups are asked to contribute. A suggested ratio from New York for excess donations from groups who have already paid for their expenses and have amassed a prudent reserve would be as follows:

#### Intergroup: 50%; General Service Board: 30%; District 45: 10%; Area 59: 10%

YAI's annual budget minimum overhead is approximately \$5,000.00. This is just to keep the lights on with a physical address as required for our incorporation. Historical contributions run between \$12,000 and \$14,000 per year. On average, 12th Step Work in our community comprises approximately 62% of our outlay for expenses. This includes the Hotline phone service we provide, meeting cards, Public Information, Fellowship Activities, and some sundry expenses to facilitate meetings and the like.


